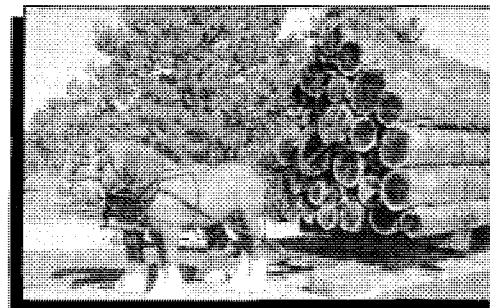
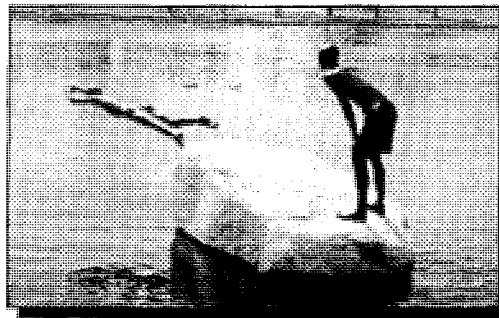
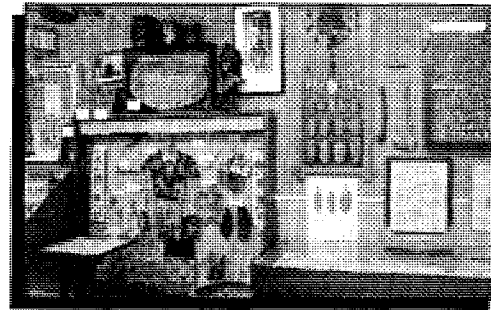
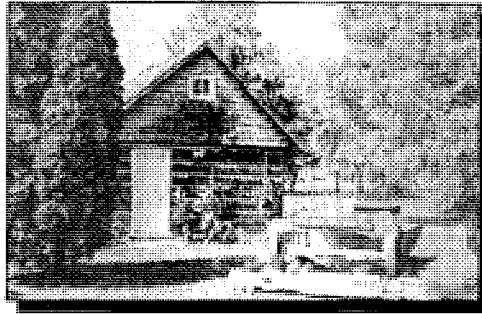
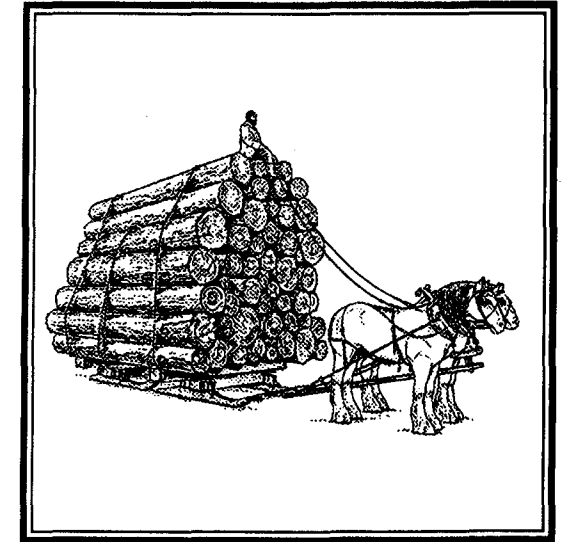


THE HISTORICAL MUSEUM

- History lesson for history buffs featuring Native American culture along the Menominee River, dioramas, tools, weapons, clothing, birch bark and dugout canoes.
- The logging era; a miniature logging camp of the 1800's, "when white pine was king" displaying buildings, tools, horse drawn equipment, bunkhouse, blacksmith shop and workers.
- 'Queen' Marinette; her story, the city and county's name honor her as a 19th century trading post owner, and pillar of the community.
- In the museum yard, see the ice road rutter rig which cut ruts in the iced roads the same width as logging sleigh runners to keep the sleigh on the tracks.
- The Evanchek log cabin is 100 years old. Restored and furnished an example of 19th century living!
- Old Marinette lives on in an exhibit of Senator Isaac "Ike" Stephenson's furniture, photographs, portraits, and memorabilia.
